## WILD LOCALITY:

Mexico (only found in the Xochimilco River Canal in Mexico City)

# **HABITAT:**

Cool Freshwater Wetlands

#### LIFESTYLE:

Strictly Aquatic (under water)

### DIET:

Worms, Insect Larva, Insects, Other Amphibians, & Fish (carnivore)

### LIFE EXPECTANCY:

15-25 years in the care of humans (less in the wild)

#### **ADULT SIZE:**

8-14" & 150-230g

### **ACTIVITY:**

Cathemeral (active in the day & night)

#### **CONSERVATION STATUS:**

Critically Endangered & Decreasing

#### THREATS:

Pollution, Habitat Loss, Invasive Species, & Climate Change

#### **FUN FACTS:**

Axolotls are incredible amphibians who, instead of morphing into their final adult form as most other amphibians do, remain in a state of never growing up! They remain fully aquatic and spend their entire lives underwater, breathing with beautiful, feather-like external gills. Axolotls are amazing for so many reasons, especially for their ability to regenerate any & all body parts if needed, & have been shown to regrow their limbs, tails, gills, & internal organs (even their brains!!)
